अब सराय काले खां से एयरोसिटी पहुंचने में लगेंगे मात्र 15 मिनट

नई दिल्ली, 12 जनवरी
रैपिड रेल के दिल्ली-मेरठ और दिल्ली-अलवर रूट जुड़ने से एयरपोर्ट तक पहुंचना सबसे आसान हो जाएगा। दिल्ली के साथ-साथ नोएडा, गाजियाबाद और गुरुग्राम के यात्रियों के लिए भी एयरपोर्ट तक जाने में जाम का झंझट खत्म हो जाएगा। सराय काले खां से एयरोसिटी के लिए मात्र 15 मिनट का समय लगेगा।

इसी तरह राजीव चौक (गुरुग्राम) से भी एयरोसिटी तक दस मिनटों में पहुंचा जा सकेगा। दिल्ली-अलवर रूट के पहले चरण के डीपीआर को एनसीआरटीसी बोर्ड ने मंजूरी दे दी है। इसके मुताबिक, एयरोसिटी तक पूरे एनसीआर की पहुंच बन जाएगी। नोएडा के यात्री मेट्रो से न्यू अशोक



नगर तक पहुंचेंगे और वहां से रैपिड रेल में सवार हो जाएंगे। गाजियाबाद के यात्रियों को दिल्ली-मेरठ रूट पर रैपिड रेल मिल जाएगी। इसी तरह गुरुग्राम के यात्री दिल्ली अलवर रूट वाली रैपिड रेल में सवार हो जाएंगे। डीपीआर मंजूर की गई है। डीपीआर के मुताबिक, पहले चरण में दिल्ली-गुरुग्राम-एनएनबी (शाहजहांपुर-नीमराना-बेहरोर) आरआरटीएस कॉरिडोर को लागू किया जाएगा। 106 किमी लंबे इस कॉरिडोर में लगभग 71 किमी (11 स्टेशन)

एलिवेटेड होगा, जबकि शेष 35 किमी (पांच स्टेशन) भूमिगत रहेगा। दिल्ली और गुरुग्राम में इसे भूमिगत रखा गया है।

एनसीआर टीसी के सीपीआरओ सुधीर शर्मा ने बताया कि हाईस्पीड ट्रेन की प्रोक्वेसी दस मिनट से कम होगी। इससे यात्रियों को बगैर जाम में फंसे यात्रा की सुविधा मिलेगी। एयरपोर्ट जैसे स्थान पर आने में बेहद कम समय लगेगा। अभी मेरठ से यात्रा करने वाले यात्रियों को सड़क मार्ग से एरोसिटी तक पहुंचने में तीन घंटे से ज्यादा का समय लगता है। इसके शुरू होने पर इस सफर के लिए महज 65 मिनट ही लगेगा।

दिल्ली मेट्रो स्टेशन के साथ एरोसिटी के आरआरटीएस स्टेशन को भी जोड़ने की योजना है। इससे ज्यादा से ज्यादा लोगों को कारिडोर का लाभ होगा।

एनसीआरटीसी ने पहले चरण में रैपिड रेल के लिए तीन कारिडोर बनाए हैं। इनमें दिल्ली-गाजियाबाद-मेरठ (82 किमी), दिल्ली-सोनीपत-पानीपत (103 किमी) और दिल्ली-गुरुग्राम-एनएनबी (शाहजहांपुर-नीमराना-बेहरोर अर्बन कॉम्प्लेक्स) (106 किमी) शामिल हैं।

दिल्ली-मेरठ रूट के बाद दिल्ली अलवर रूट पर बोर्ड ने डीपीआर पास कर दी है। इस खंड पर पाइल-लोडिंग टेस्ट और भू तकनीकी सर्वेक्षण के लिए निविदाएं भी आमंत्रित की गई हैं। दिल्ली-गाजियाबाद-मेरठ आरआरटीएस कॉरिडोर का पहला चरण शुरू हो गया है। इसके तहत भू-तकनीकी सर्वेक्षण, सड़क को चौड़ा करना और जरूरी इन्फ्रास्ट्रक्चर जैसे निर्माण से पहले के कार्य चल रहे हैं।

32 करोड़ की हेरोइन बरामद

नई दिल्ली, 12 जनवरी

स्पेशल सेल ने दो अंतरराष्ट्रीय ड्रग्स तस्करो को 32 करोड़ की हेरोइन के साथ पकड़ा है। इनमें 27 वर्षीय अफगानी नागरिक असादुल्लाह और 31 वर्षीय नाइजीरियाई मॉउसा जी शामिल हैं। अफगानी तस्कर अपने पेट में हेरोइन के कैप्सूल रखकर दिल्ली लाता था और वहां कुछ अफ्रीकी सप्लायरों को ड्रग्स की खेप सौंप देता था। इसके बाद वे देश-विदेश में इसकी सप्लाय करते थे। पुलिस उपायुक्त प्रमोद कुशवाह ने बताया कि एसीपी अतर सिंह और इंस्पेक्टर ईश्वर सिंह की टीम ने असादुल्लाह को मालवीय नगर से बुधवार को गिरफ्तार किया था। आरोपी से ने छह किलो हेरोइन बरामद हुई, जिसकी अंतरराष्ट्रीय बाजार में कीमत 24 करोड़ रुपये है। उसने पूछताछ में मॉउसा का नाम बताया। इसके बाद पुलिस ने साकित से मॉउसा को भी दबोचा लिया। मॉउसा असादुल्लाह से ड्रग्स की खेप लेता था। उसके पास से भी दो किलो हेरोइन बरामद हुई है। असादुल्लाह कई बार ड्रग्स की बड़ी खेप लेकर भारत आ चुका है। वह कई बार अपने साथियों से भी हेरोइन मंगवा चुका है।

वह पेट में हेरोइन के कैप्सूल रखकर लाता था और इस बार वह मेडिकल वीजा हेरोइन लेकर भारत आया था। मॉउसा जुलाई 2017 में छह महीने के टूरिस्ट वीजा पर भारत आया था। इसके बाद से वह अवैध तौर पर भारत में रहकर ड्रग्स सप्लाय का धंधा कर रहा था।

दिल्ली में बेटी की कब्र पर ही कर दी पिता की हत्या

उत्तर पूर्वी दिल्ली के वेलकम इलाके में शुक्रवार दोपहर माता चौक के पास स्थित कब्रिस्तान में बेटी की कब्र पर प्रार्थना करने गए प्रॉपर्टी डीलर को अज्ञात हमलावरों ने गोलीयां से भून दिया। गंभीर रूप से घायल 33 वर्षीय प्रॉपर्टी डीलर महफूज खान की मौके पर ही मौत हो गई। उन्हें करीब छह गोलीयां मारी गई हैं। पुलिस हत्या के पीछे आपसी रंजिश और रुपयों के लेनदेन का विवाद मानकर मामले की जांच कर रही है। हालांकि, अभी यह पता नहीं चल सका है कि हमलावरों की संख्या कितनी थी। पुलिस हमलावरों की पहचान के लिए आसपास के कैमरों की सीसीटीवी फुटेज खंगालने के साथ पीड़ित परिवारों से

भी पूछताछ कर रही है। वहीं, हत्या को लेकर इलाके के लोगों में गुस्सा है। अधिकारियों ने मौके पर भारी संख्या में पुलिस बल तैनात किया है। पुलिस के अनुसार, महफूज खान परिवार के साथ वेलकम इलाके में माता चौक के पास रहते थे। उनका प्रॉपर्टी डीलिंग और बेकरी का व्यवसाय है। उनके भाई सलमान खान ने बताया कि शुक्रवार दोपहर 1:15 बजे महफूज नमाज पढ़ने के बाद घर के पास ही कब्रिस्तान में अपनी बेटी की कब्र पर गए थे। इस दौरान वहां पहुंचे अज्ञात हमलावर उन पर ताबड़तोड़ गोलीयां बरसाकर फरार हो गए। सूचना पर परिजन मौके पर पहुंचे और महफूज को पास के अस्पताल में ले गए, जहां डॉक्टर ने उन्हें मृत घोषित कर दिया। महफूज के पेट, सीने और सिर में दो

गोलियां लगी हैं, जबकि एक गोली उनके हाथ को छूकर निकल गई। परिजनों के अनुसार, महफूज खान को तीन वर्षीय बेटी अलीना की दो साल पहले बीमारी के चलते मौत हो गई थी। घर के पास कब्रिस्तान के आसपास पुलिस बल की तैनाती की गई है। पुलिस के अनुसार, मृतक का भी अपराधिक इतिहास रहा है, ऐसे में पुलिस पुरानी रंजिश में हत्या की आशंका जाहिर कर रही है। इसके अलावा पुलिस रुपयों के लेनदेन को लेकर हत्या करने के कोण से भी जांच कर रही है। उत्तर पूर्वी दिल्ली डीसीपी अनुल कुमार ठाकुर ने कहा, अभी हत्या की वजह पता नहीं चल सकी है। मृतक का भी अपराधिक रहा है। उसे लेकर भी जांच की जा रही है। मामले के खुलासे के लिए कई टीमों को लगाया गया है।

12 गांवों के किसानों को मालामाल कर देगा नया हाईवे

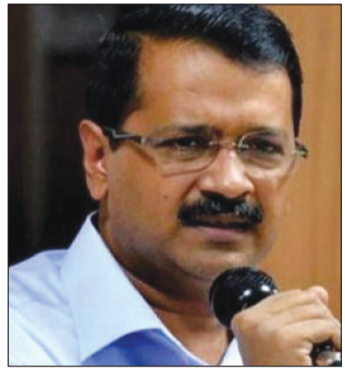

अक्षरधाम से खेकड़ा तक बनने वाले नए हाईवे से सैकड़ों किसान मालामाल होंगे। भारतीय राष्ट्रीय राजमार्ग प्राधिकरण (एनएचआई) प्रोजेक्ट के लिए लोनी तहसील के 12 गांव के किसानों की जमीन का अधिग्रहण करेगा। किसानों को नए भूमि अधिग्रहण एक्ट के हिसाब से मुआवजा दिया जाएगा। हाईवे का निर्माण मार्च में शुरू कराने की तैयारी है। भारत माला परियोजना के तहत दिल्ली के अक्षरधाम मंदिर के पास (दिल्ली-मेरठ एक्सप्रेस-वे) से खेकड़ा तक यह हाईवे बनाया जाएगा। हाईवे को खेकड़ा (मवीकला गांव) में ईस्टर्न पेरिफेरल एक्सप्रेस-वे और दिल्ली-सहारनपुर हाईवे से जोड़ा जाएगा। हाईवे बनाने का काम तेजी से होना है। इसके लिए जमीन अधिग्रहण की प्रक्रिया जल्द की जाएगी।

एनएचआई को हाईवे निर्माण के लिए लोनी क्षेत्र के 12 गांव के किसानों की जमीन का अधिग्रहण करना है। सभी गांवों की सूची तैयार कर ली गई है। किसानों को नोटिस भेजने की तैयारी की जा रही है। जिन गांव के किसानों की जमीन का अधिग्रहण किया जाना है उनके नाम प्रशासन को भेजे जाएंगे। नए भूमि अधिग्रहण एक्ट के तहत किसानों को मुआवजा दिया जाएगा। भू अधिग्रहण विभाग के अनुसार किसानों को सफिल रेट के हिसाब से शहरी क्षेत्र में दो गुना और देहात क्षेत्र में चार गुना मुआवजा दिया जाएगा। इन गांव की जमीन का अधिग्रहण होगा : लोनी देहात, हकीकतपुर, सैदुलाबाद, पावली, सदकपुर, शादाबाद दुर्गावली, अगरोला, मिलक बामला, मंडौला और नानू गांव के किसानों की जमीन का अधिग्रहण किया जाएगा। 32 किलोमीटर से ज्यादा लंबी सड़क पर एक टोल प्लाजा बनाया जाएगा। लोनी में टोल प्लाजा बनाया जाना है। इसके लिए जमीन भी देख ली गई है। टोल बनाने पर अधिकारियों के बीच मंथन हो गया है। एनएचआई ने इस बारे में जिलाधिकारी को भी अवगत करा दिया है।

दिल्ली की वायु गुणवत्ता फिर हुई 'गंभीर' बारिश से मिल सकती है राहत

नई दिल्ली, 12 जनवरी

दिल्ली की वायु गुणवत्ता शनिवार को हवा की धीमी गति के चलते एक बार फिर 'गंभीर' श्रेणी में पहुंच गई। हालांकि, अधिकारियों ने अगले कुछ दिनों में बारिश होने का अनुमान बताया है जिससे प्रदूषण का स्तर कम होने की संभावना है। केंद्रीय प्रदूषण नियंत्रण बोर्ड (सीपीसीबी) के आंकड़ों के मुताबिक, शहर का कुल वायु गुणवत्ता सूचकांक 410 था जो 'गंभीर' श्रेणी में माना जाता है। सीपीसीबी ने बताया कि 22 इलाकों में हवा की गुणवत्ता 'गंभीर' दर्ज की गई, जबकि 13 इलाकों में यह 'बेहद खराब' रही। राष्ट्रीय राजधानी क्षेत्र (एनसीआर) के गाजियाबाद, नोएडा एवं ग्रेटर नोएडा में भी वायु गुणवत्ता 'गंभीर' दर्ज की गई।



उत्तर-चढ़ाव के साथ कुल वायु गुणवत्ता और खराब हो सकती है। अन्य मौसमी स्थितियां भी अनुकूल नहीं हैं। हालांकि कोहरे की स्थितियों के अब छंटने की संभावना है। 'गंभीर' श्रेणी में पहुंचने से पहले शुक्रवार को हवा की गुणवत्ता 'बेहद खराब' रही। हवा की तेज गति की वजह से हवा कुछ साफ हुई थी और बुधवार एवं गुरुवार को वायु गुणवत्ता 'खराब' श्रेणी में थी।

After killing, burying nephew in balcony, uncle went to try luck in films

New Delhi/January 12
In October last year, as the winter season was about to set in, Kajal Gupta had come to her mother's house in Dabri. There she would often sit out on the mud pile in the flat's third floor balcony and have food while soaking in the sun. Little did she know that she was sitting on the corpse of a software engineer, which lay buried under the mud, she said on Friday.

The engineer's body was recovered on October 8 last year, almost three years after he was killed, when Gupta and her family members requested their landlord, 86-year-old Vikram Singh, to get the balcony of their flat renovated. During the renovation, when the boundary of the balcony was demolished, labourers found a human skeletal remains and alerted the police. The man was later



identified as Jai Prakash Maharana (26), once a tenant at Singh's three storey building, that has 11 flats. Jai shared the flat with his maternal uncle Bijay Kumar Maharana, who police arrested from Hyderabad on January 6 this month, almost three years after the murder. Police said Bijay disliked Jai's closeness to his girlfriend and therefore bludgeoned him to death on February 7, 2016. Police said that Bijay,

who had been hiding in Hyderabad, had changed his looks and had cut contacts with his family and friends was trying his luck in regional films. Gupta, who still lives in the house, on Friday termed her experience as "haunting". "It was hard to believe we had already spent about ten days with a dead body buried right next to us. Even the labourers who were digging were shocked. They silently

left the spot and went straight to the police," said Gupta, whose mother, younger sister and brother live in the house as permanent residents.

Gupta, who is married and is a frequent visitor to the house, said that on Wednesday police brought Bijay to the house to recreate the crime scene.

"While recreating the crime scene at the house, Bijay showed police the spot where Jai was sleeping. At the spot, Bijay had attacked him with a ceiling fan motor. This is the exact spot where we sleep. I have been staying here for the last two months. The murderer (Bijay) also gave a detailed description to the police about how he buried the body and planted saplings on it. We saw his face. It didn't have any remorse," said, Gupta, a bank employee.

Gupta also said that Jai's mother had come to Delhi and she stayed in the same flat for a few days after the body was recovered. She had also stayed in the house when her son went missing, unaware that her son was buried within metres of where she was sleeping. Vikram Singh, the landlord who owns the flat, said he had visited the house when Bijay spread rumours that Jai had gone missing. "I had gone to the house but found Jai's room locked. That was the only way to the balcony. Bijay had locked the room from outside and told me that Jai has gone to Vashno Devi," Singh said. Police officers said they are yet to recover the fan motor with which Bijay had bludgeoned Jai. "He told us that he washed the blood on the fan and took it out on the pretext of getting it repaired. He said he threw the fan in a nearby drain. We searched for the fan but are yet to recover it," said an investigator.

One dead as school bus hits NDMC gardeners on cycle

An NDMC gardener died and his colleague sustained serious injuries after the bicycle on which they were travelling was hit by a private bus carrying school children near Khan Market Friday. While 59-year-old Rajender Prasad was killed on the spot because of head injuries, 46-year-old Rajender Singh sustained fractures in his legs, injuries to his spine, neck and head, officials from Ram Manohar Lohia hospital said. The victims were employed as gardeners and were posted with the New Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) enquiry office. Police are yet to trace the errant driver, who abandoned the bus and fled the spot, leaving the children and teachers behind. Singh was riding the bicycle and Prasad was sitting

behind him. "The bus came from the rear and hit them. We have registered a case of rash and negligent driving at Tughlak Road police station," said DCP (New Delhi) Madhur Verma. Police questioned children and teachers from Sarvodaya Kanya Vidyalaya, Burari, who were at the time en route to visit the Lotus Temple near Nehru Place, but did not unearth anything conclusive, an officer said. The PCR call was made at 11.16 am and a police team reached the spot to find the private bus, the broken bicycle and blood on the spot, the officer said. Colleagues of both gardeners said they had been coming to work on bicycles every day for the last two decades, travelling 20 km to get there from home. Once they got to work, they would punch in and take their bicycles to run errands. Prasad had bought a scooter around four months ago.

Documentary on missing JNU student Najeeb Ahmad screened

Seeking 'divine help' to de-seal shops in Delhi's Amar Colony

Sitting on a podium at a pavement in the Amar Colony market — where around 400 shops had been sealed by the municipal corporation last March — Laxmi Narayan, a man in his 70s, chants a doha (prayer). With the loudspeaker attached to his microphone kept on full volume, the chant reverberates all around, raising hopes among shopkeepers in the area.

Narayan — a priest who arrived in the city from Mehandipur Balaji in Rajasthan just days ago — has taken upon himself the task of ensuring that the shops are reopened soon, by conducting a nine-day religious ritual and chanting mantras.

But it was only by chance that Narayan had come to know of the sealing of shops in



the market. Around six days ago, Narayan had landed up in the market, looking for a particular shop. But when he saw most of the shops with their shutters down, he asked some shopkeepers in the area the reason behind this blanket shutdown.

When the shopkeepers described their problems since the sealing drive, conducted on the recommendation of Supreme Court-appointed monitoring committee, Narayan told them it was time for divine intervention.

"I was crossing the market when I saw all the shops closed. I asked around and got to know about the sealing drive and how the shops have been closed. That was when I suggested the shopkeepers to conduct a religious ritual to get their shops opened," Narayan, who originally hails from Punjab, said.

The shopkeepers — who had, till then, lost all hopes of justice and recovering their losses — found hope in his words and decided to be part of the ritual.

Sanjay Arora, the owner of a shop in the busy market, sprung into action to organise the programme after Narayan told him that he would chant mantras for nine days so that his prayers reach the people who have sealed the market and they take back their orders. Arora, who has run from pillar to post to get his shop desealed, said organising the

ritualistic prayer was his last-ditch attempt to revive the shop and his livelihood. "Panditji came to me one day and suggested we should do conduct a religious prayer to get our shops desealed. We want our sources of livelihood back. Hence, we agreed to make this effort and organised this," Arora said.

Another shopkeeper, Manmohan Shyam Mehra, said they tried all possible ways to get their shops desealed and met all authorities, pleading for their mercy. However, he said, none of them have listened to their ordeals. "We have gone everywhere but nothing positive has happened. We are even ready to pay fines. Despite that, the authorities are not ready to budge from their stand. I am bankrupt and have borrowed money from the relatives to pay my children's school fees," Mehra said.

New manual being implemented in city jails

The Delhi government on Thursday informed the Delhi high court that it had implemented the new jail manual in all the three prisons in the capital from January 1. It said the new manual would address issues of prison reforms and bring basic uniformity in rules. Rahul Mehra, standing counsel for the Delhi government, informed a bench of Chief Justice Rajendra Menon and Justice V Kameswar Rao that the new manual has been notified and was now being followed by the authorities. The submissions were made by Mehra during the hearing of a bunch of pleas that highlighted human rights violations and conditions in the prison, including poor medical facilities. Mehra told the court that all issues pertaining to human rights violation would change after the implementation of the new jail manual. Following this, the court asked the amicus curiae to go through the manual and list out any issue that needed to be addressed. Earlier, the Delhi government had informed the court that the new jail manual would address all issues, including open and semi open jails, furlough and parole guidelines. The matter would be now heard in April 2019.

Work on two U-turns kicks off in Gurgaon
